- Background: The chosen site for the project is right in front of the former tanners' market, where many tanners settled on the border of the Bièvre, a tributary of the Seine.

Currently, the site is being occupied by the organization CÉSURE. In practice, what is now known as the former campus of the university of Paris 3 Sorbonne Nouvelle has become in essence Césure, a place run Plateau urbain and their partner YES WE CAMP.

Site Study: The University of Paris 3 Sorbonne Nouvelle, a building from the 1960's, is in the 5th arrondissement of Paris, which is a heterogeneous historical and wealthy area, an important population of students but also on top of the archaeological Pantheon and Gallo-Roman remains. The University of Paris 3 showcases inequalities and alternative appropriations.



The site: The building is therefore a field of experimentation of social economy, a space of solidarity that brings new actors, activities, perceptions in the area. The place is shared with 2000 students every day.

This example of transitory urbanism with the several associations that occupy the place, aims to develop social actions and projects for equality and local social needs, social and solidarity-based economy.
